Covid –19 and Camp KV

Updated 1/22/2021

Our 2020 Camp KV season was a success beyond our expectations. We provided 12 weeks of summer camp at two locations with 0 cases of COVID-19. This was done through individual commitment to health and hygiene, with the cooperation of our camp families and partners to assure the safety of campers outside of Camp KV and also through the incredible dedication of your Camp KV staff.

Last year we made sacrifices to ensure camp- wide and community health and we will continue to make those sacrifices this summer. Although, we hate to cancel of the highly anticipated and beloved camp activities, we must do what is best for the greater good. We are going to stick with what worked in 2020 in order to move closer to the day when Camp KV can run in full without accommodations made to the pandemic.

1. All overnights and overnight activities will be cancelled including the family campfire. All 10 weeks will be Monday - Friday 8am - 4pm except for week 4 which is Tuesday - Friday.
2. Any camper coming into Maine from another state must follow all CDC COVID – 19 protocol. This includes Maine residents who leave the state during the camp season.
3. Camp KV will enforce social distancing protocol set forth by the State of Maine. All campers and staff will be required to wear a face mask or other 2 ply fabric face covering. Instead of camp t-shirts, all campers and staff will be given a face covering while at camp. Parents are encouraged to supply their kids with their own masks as well. Masks should be cleaned in accordance with CDC guidelines.
5. We are only going to permit health support professionals and other essential support staff at Camp KV while campers are present. Parents coming to pick up campers early must call and arrange a scheduled pick up as a way to limit additional exposure.
6. We are only offering bus services from the Augusta campus to Camp KV (no Manchester service). Campers will be health screened and given hand sanitizer each morning prior to boarding the bus. Face masks must be worn at all times while on the bus.

CIT's walk away with:

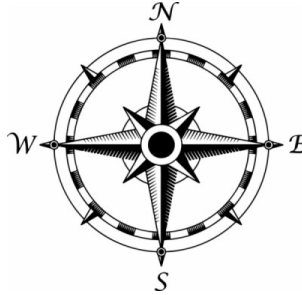
- American Red Cross CPR/First Aid Certification

TEEN WILDERNESS WEEK



This year, we welcome our oldest campers to Camp KV for this exciting NEW outdoor program!

This experience is designed to provide hands-on experience learning the foundations of camping, wood craft, nature knowledge and wilderness survival.

All campers will learn how to:

- Use the tools of the woods-axe, saw and knife
- Tie the 5 essential woods knots
- Light, maintain, use and feed a campfire
- Set up a safe and comfortable camp

SIGN IN/SIGN OUT

All campers must be signed in and out daily by a parent/guardian. For your child's safety, photo ID's will be required. For first time pick-ups, please remind other authorized pick-ups that they will need to bring a photo ID with them, as well.

ABSENCES

If your child is not going to attend camp for the day, please report their absence by calling the camp office at 207 685 4644 or email Paul Sveum at paul@kvymca.org

If your child will be leaving early, please call or notify the camp office in writing of what time and who will be picking up your child.

RAINY DAYS AT CAMP KV

On rainy days, we try to do as much activity outside as possible, which means your campers should come prepared with water-resistant clothing on damp days. On days of heavy rain, we utilize our covered areas and main lodge, where campers engage in indoor activities.

SWIMMING

Campers will have the opportunity to swim at Camp KV. For their safety, all campers will be swim tested on their first day of camp. While swim activities are not required, we strongly encourage all campers to participate.

Lifeguards will be on duty whenever children are in the water.

LUNCH

Lunch will NOT be provided to campers. Please pack a healthy lunch along with a few healthy snacks that will last all day. There is limited space for campers to keep perishable foods cold. Please try to send lunch boxes with ice packs.

Please be sure to bring a re-fillable water bottle every day and remember to label everything with your child's name.



CAMP POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

DAILY CAMP CHECKLIST

Each camper should bring a backpack with the following items:

- Bathing Suit (one-piece or tankini) & Towel
- Plastic Bag (for wet clothes/towels)
- Healthy snacks & lunch
- Facial covering (2)
- Refillable water bottle
- An extra set of clothes
- Sunscreen! Please make sure campers are wearing sunscreen when they arrive at camp.
- Jacket or sweatshirt for cool weather
- Closed-toe shoes are required. Flip flops can be worn only at the waterfront.

Please label everything!

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

- Electronic devices
- Cell phones / tablets / computers / cameras
- Toys / trading Cards / sports equipment
- Money / valuable Items
- Weapons of any kind - real or fake

The KV YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items

PARENT AND VISITOR POLICY

Typically we welcome all visitors to camp, especially parents, but this year we are asking that trips to Camp KV are limited to necessary visits due to COVID - 19 protocol.

BUS POLICY

Parents must be at pick-ups and drop-offs and are responsible for the supervision of their children before entering the care of the YMCA. Children will not be allowed on the bus without pre-registration and payment completed. If for any reason a camper's transportation has not arrived at the end of the day, parents will be notified for pick-up and may be subject to a late fee.

Campers are expected to follow Camp KV rules while on the bus. Any behavior not in accordance with Camp KV policies will result in parent notification, seat assignment and possible expulsion from the bus program.

BUS SCHEDULES

Busses leave Augusta at 7:40 am

Buses return to Augusta at 4:30 pm

Arrive at 7:20 for the drop off / check in process and plan on being at the Augusta Y at 4:20 for pick up.



CAMPER CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

The staff governs the behavior of each child and attempts to work through conflicts and problems as they occur. A camper who displays negative behavior can affect the rest of the camp's experience. Campers who are disruptive, display inappropriate behavior, or require an undue amount of disciplinary attention will meet with the Camp Director to evaluate their behavior. Parents will be notified of any misconduct or discipline problems. It will be the parent's responsibility to arrange transportation for the child if he/she is being sent home due to disciplinary actions.

If an incident occurs that jeopardizes a camper's safety, the safety of others, or is not in accordance with the mission of the YMCA, camp staff will address and document the issue directly with the child and take the following steps.

- 1. First Violation:** The child may be removed from an activity for the day, such as swimming, free time, etc. Parents may be contacted during the day or at the end of camp depending on the time and severity of the incident.
- 2. Second Violation:** The parent/guardian will receive a phone call and may be asked to pick up their child within the hour. The child may or may not be allowed to attend camp the next day that they are registered for depending on the severity of the incident.
- 3. Third Violation:** Parents may be contacted immediately to pick up their child from camp. The child will be suspended for the day or week that they are registered for depending on the severity of the incident.
- 4. Fourth Violation:** Child may be dismissed from camp for the remainder of the program depending on the severity of the incident.

*Please Note: We reserve the right to, at any time, dismiss your child from the program immediately due to environmental, physical, emotional, or other harm to themselves, other children, and staff. Refunds will not be given for suspension or dismissal.

BULLYING

At Camp KV, bullying is inexcusable, and we have a firm policy against all types of bullying. Each camper is expected to treat all other campers and staff with respect. Our Camp Director addresses all incidents of bullying and trains staff to create a safe and welcoming environment for all.

HEALTHY CAMPERS

If your child contracts anything that may be contagious, please let us know. Your name will be kept confidential but state regulations require us to post any contagious illnesses to all participants.

If your child shows any sign of illness, rash, high temperature (over 100.4), diarrhea, infection, lice, or any contagious diseases, the parent/guardian will be called and expected to pick up the child within one hour.

While camp staff do their best to prevent injuries, sometimes they do happen. Moderate injuries will be communicated to the parent once proper first aid has taken place. If severe injuries need higher medical attention, 911 will be called and parent/guardian will be contacted immediately.

MEDICATION

Medication must be brought in its original container, allowing for proper identification and dosage, as required by state licensing. Please leave all medications with a staff member at drop-off and they will bring it to the Director's Cabin to be locked up. Campers should not have medication in their lunch boxes or backpacks.

Any medications that are to be self-administered (i.e., inhaler) by a camper must be accompanied by a completed Self Administered Medical Form (attached) and returned before their first day of camp.



Minor Participant Waiver, Release, Indemnification of All Claims & Covenant Not to Sue (Youth Programming/ Childcare/ Camp KV)

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND IS LEGALLY BINDING. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU ARE RELEASING THE KENNEBEC VALLEY YMCA FROM ALL LIABILITY AND FOREVER GIVING UP ANY CLAIMS THEREFORE

Assumption of Risk

I, _____, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of the minor named below (“Minor”), acknowledge and agree that any use of the Kennebec Valley YMCA facilities, services, equipment and premises (“Facilities”) and any participation in the Kennebec Valley YMCA programs and activities (“Programs”) comes with inherent risks including, but in no way limited to: (1) moderate and severe personal injury, (2) property damage, (3) disability, (4) death, and (5) sickness or disease. I voluntarily, for myself and Minor, accept and assume full responsibility for these risks as well as any and all other risks of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs. I agree that I have full knowledge of the nature and extent of all such risks and am not relying on all such risks being described in this document.

Waiver, Release, Indemnification & Covenant Not to Sue

In consideration of Minor’s use of Facilities and participation in Programs I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor that the Kennebec Valley YMCA, its officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, insurers and representatives (“Releasees”) will not be liable for any personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease incurred by Minor, however occurring including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees. I understand that Minor and I will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease sustained from the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.

I further agree, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of Minor, on behalf of Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies, to release and **HEREBY DO RELEASE, WAIVE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE** Releasees from any causes of action, claims, suits, liabilities or demands of any nature whatsoever including, but in no way limited to, claims of negligence, which Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies may have, now or in the future, against Releasees on account of personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness, disease or accident of any kind, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities or participation in Programs, whether that participation is supervised or unsupervised, however the injury or damage occurs, including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees.

In further consideration of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs, I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor to **INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Releasees from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, losses, suits, liabilities or costs of any nature whatsoever, including claims of negligence, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.
