Membership Details

PLEASE NOTE:

A membership can only receive one type of savings. Purchasing a year in full or for place of employment

DRAFT MEMBERS:

If at any point the membership needs to be cancelled, please come in to fill out cancellation form at least 15 days prior to your draft date in order to stop the draft before the next month. Drafting is a 3 month minimum requirement.

DEFINITIONS:

Senior Member: A couple in which at least one spouse is 65 or older.

Family: A couple living in the same household as their dependent children less than 18 years of age, unless child is under 23 and enrolled in school full time.

One Parent Family: Same as above, but with only one parent active on the membership.

OPEN DOORS:

At the Y, no one is turned away for their inability to pay. Financial assistance is available through our Open Doors Scholarship Program. Partially funded by the United Way

CORPORATE WELLNESS PROGRAMS:

Receive 10% off membership when your company enrolls . There is no cost to the employer for enrollment and no minimum number of employees to qualify. The Partnership Subsidy Program would allow your company to pay all or part of your membership monthly.
