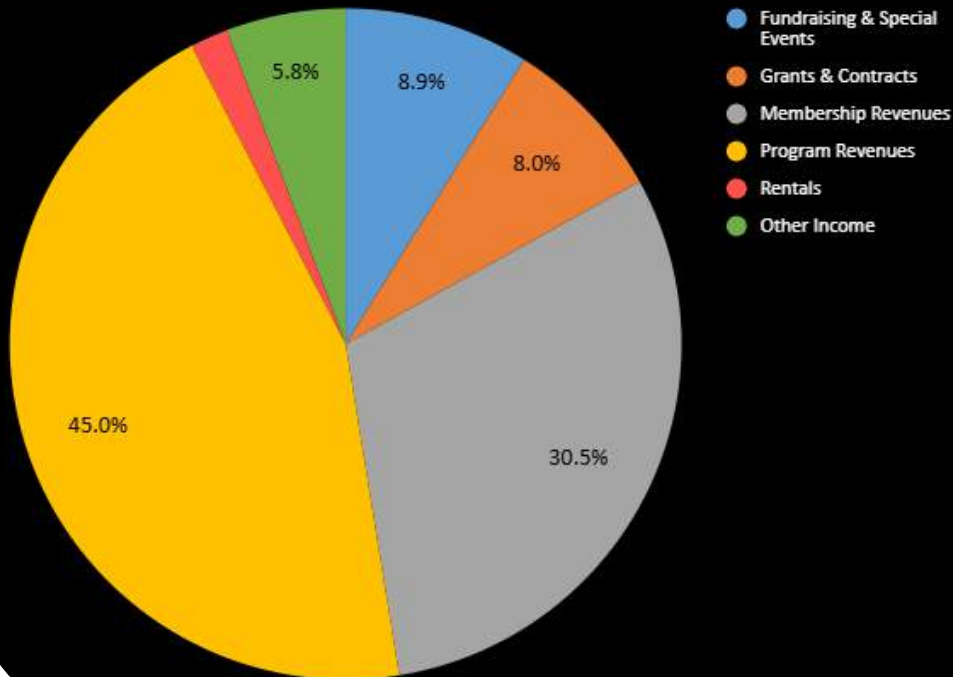

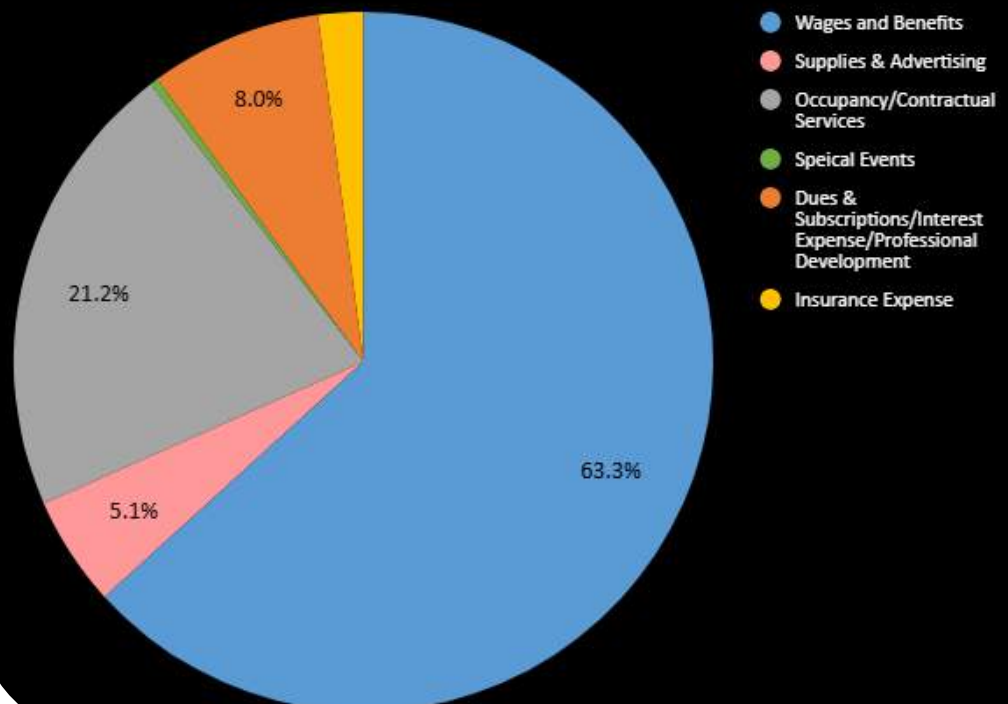

Kennebec Valley YMCA - FY 2024 Revenues



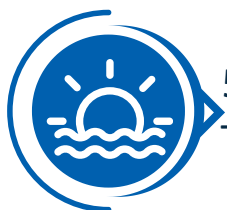
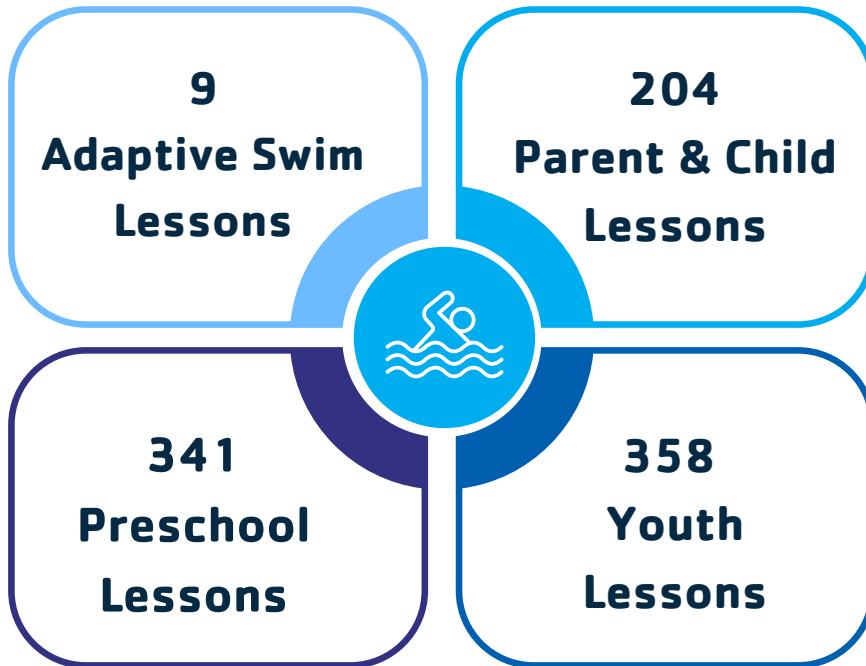
Kennebec Valley YMCA - FY 2024 Expenditures

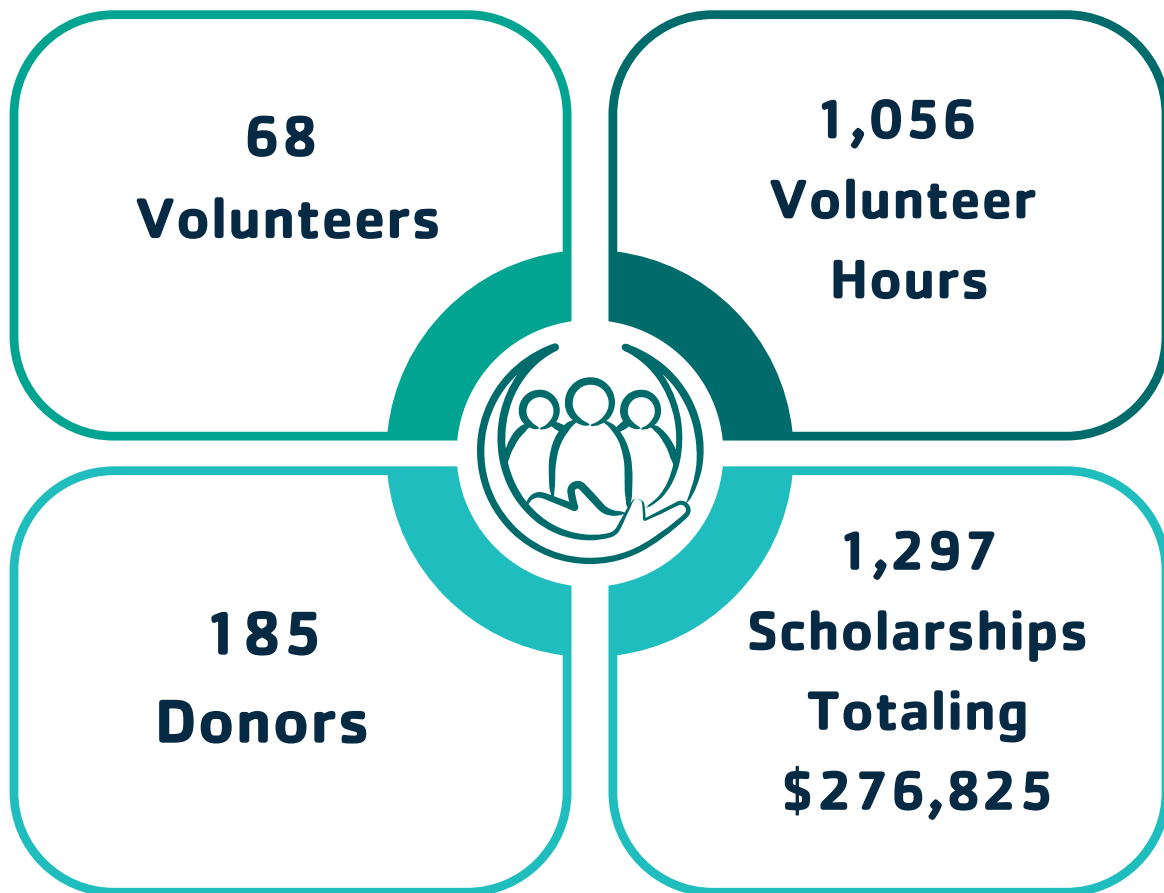
